

## **Classification Schedule for ParAthletics 2016 IPC Athletics Grand Prix**

Dear Team Leaders,

Please find attached the first version of the PI, VI and II Classification Schedules for the ParAthletics - 2016 IPC Athletics Grand Prix (Nottwil, **24-25 May**).

Only athletes who are registered and who uploaded the required documents to the SDMS (Medical Diagnostics Forms) are scheduled. Those who did not yet upload the requested documents are kindly reminded to do so, and once the documents are uploaded the athletes will be scheduled for classification.

Please be reminded of the Athlete Evaluation Requirements as found in the IPC Athletics Classification Rules and Regulations (Article 4).

Failure to comply with these Rules may lead to the suspension of Athlete Evaluation which will preclude the athlete from competing at any competition until Athlete Evaluation is completed.

### Medical Diagnostic Forms (PI/VI Classification):

All Athletes must submit a Medical Diagnostics Form to SDMS before the athlete undergoes Athlete Evaluation. Medical documentation serves the purpose of providing evidence of the athletes' eligible impairment, and is as such crucial for athlete evaluation and sport class allocation. The International Standard of Athlete Evaluation (Article 3.2) as part of the IPC Classification Code requires athletes to provide such supporting medical documentation.
